RISK ASSESSMENT PLAYGROUND

Last Review Date: April 2023 Policy No. 8B Issued: 2019

- 1. Staff member must complete a risk assessment of the playground before entering with the children(i.e. check external gates are locked properly, check all surfaces of the garden, the ground area for stones and any rubbish, climbing frames for loose parts and ensure they are fit for use).
- 2. Register book must be brought to the garden and head counts must be done every 10 minutes. Head count must also be done before leaving the garden.
- 3. Climbing frame area must have 2 staff members on it at all times when in use, one staff member at each end (if applicable).
- 4. Staff must remain vigilant at all times when in the garden.
- 5. During the summer months, sun cream must be applied to the children before entering the garden, monitored and reapplied when necessary. Sun hats should also be worn for babies/wobblers.
- 6. All garden equipment must be cleaned daily with disinfectant.

Doors leading out of activity street into playground	 Door shutting on fingers Trip over door step 	 Ensure door is closed securely behind the children Children to walk through doorway, not run, and remind children about the step on entry into activity street 	 Monitor working order of door Adequate supervision
Play Area	o Escape	 Locks are fixed on all external gates, strong bolts are fixed on all internal gates 	Adequate supervision
Climbing Frame	 Tripping/fa Iling on/off climbing frame Poor/unsafe condition for use 	 Ensure 2 staff monitor the climbing frame at all times and ensure the climbing frame is dry and safe to use Checked by manager on a fortnightly basis 	 Adequate supervision Monitor condition of climbing frame and repair when required
Trikes and Bikes	 Poor working order Falling off Riding into someone 	 Checked by manager on a fortnightly basis Children being reminded to consider other children in the playground while using the bikes Ensure the bikes are parked to the side of the playground out of the way of the other children Trikes and bikes are only to be used on the soft pore surface 	 Monitor the condition of the trikes/bikes and replace part or the whole bike if necessary Monitor the number of children in the play area while bikes are in use and ensure that it is a controlled and safe environment
Cleanliness of equipment (i.e bikes, play equipment)	o Infections	 Disinfectant is provided for the purpose of cleaning playground equipment. 	Clean equipment weekly with disinfectant
